
TEAM-KENTUCKY



Local Government Economic Assistance Fund (LGEAF)

- Ten percent (10%) of each county allocation will be distributed to each incorporated city within the county, based on population (KRS 42.475).
- There is no requirement that funds must be spent on the coal haul road system (per HB 352).
- If any city allocation is less than \$25 in any given quarter, the allotment will be distributed to the county (KRS.475(2)).

Eligible activities include:

- a. Public Safety
- b. Environmental Protection
- c. Public Transportation
- d. Health
- e. Recreation
- f. Educational Facilities
- g. Social Services
- h. Industrial or Economic Development
- i. Vocational Education
- j. Workforce Training
- k. Secondary Wood Industry

Local Government Economic Development Fund (LGEAF)

- Funds must be allocated to projects that have the concurrence of the respective county judge/executive, state senator(s), and state representative(s) of each county.
- If concurrence cannot be achieved, the fiscal court of each county may apply for LGEDF grants for industrial development projects (KRS.4588).
