## CDBG-DR 7-7 <u>GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE FOR COMPLAINTS RELATING TO SUSPECTED</u> <u>ALLEGATIONS OF DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF HANDICAPPED STATUS IN</u> <u>MENTUCKY</u>

Any person \_\_\_\_\_\_ who believes that he/she has been subjected to discrimination as prohibited by Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and pursuant regulations at 24 CFR Part 8 published in the Federal Register on June 2, 1988, may personally or by a representative, file a complaint with \_\_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_. A person who has not personally been subjected to discrimination

may also file a complaint.

When any person, \_\_\_\_\_ who believes he/she has been adversely affected by an act or decision by \_\_\_\_\_ and that such act or decision was based on handicapped status, he/she will have the right to process a complaint or grievance in accordance with the following procedure.

**Step Two:** The \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ shall contact the complainant no later than fifteen (15) days after receiving the written statement to establish an informal meeting with the objective of resolving the matter informally. However, in no case shall the informal meeting be conducted sooner than five (5) days or more than forty-five (45) days after receiving the written statement.

There shall be prepared a written documentary of the discussions at the informal meeting, which shall be preserved in the records of \_\_\_\_\_\_.

Step Three: Within fifteen (15) days of the informal meeting, if no decision has been made by the \_\_\_\_\_, or the decision of the \_\_\_\_\_ does not satisfy the complainant, he/she may request a hearing with the \_\_\_\_\_ by submitting a written request to the \_\_\_\_\_.
