accept an objection to its approval of the release of funds and acceptance of the certification only if it is on one of the following bases:

- (a) The certification was not in fact executed by the local government's Certifying Officer.
- (b) The local government has failed to make one of the two findings pursuant to S.54.41 or to make the written determination decision required by SS.58.47, 58.53 or 58.64 for the project, as applicable.
- (c) The local government has omitted one or more of the steps set forth as Subparts F and G for the preparation and completion of an environmental assessment.
- (d) No opportunity was given to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation or its Executive Director to review the effect of the project on a property listed on the National Register of Historic places, or found to be eligible for such listing by the Secretary of the Interior, in accordance with 36 CFR Part 800.
- (e) The subrecipient has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by this part before release of funds and approval of the Environmental Certification by HUD or the state.
- (f) Objections by a federal agency.

Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedure (24 CFR Part 58), and may be addressed to:
