#### TRAINING SUMMARY

This is a detailed training about the Kentucky Fair Housing Act (KRS 344.360), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of color, disability, familial status, national origin, race, religion, sex, and retaliation in the sale or rental of housing. The training will also cover information about reasonable accommodations and modifications for qualified individuals with a disability; and will also cover the complaint process at the Kentucky Commission on Human Rights.

It is estimated that about four million fair housing violations occur each year and only one percent of these violations is reported. 27,092 fair housing charges were filed with fair housing enforcement agencies across the country in 2011. Fair housing discrimination is still prevalent in our society.
